Landscape Talks are all but ordinary academic lectures. With a length of only 7 min they offer an entertaining, inspiring and engaging way of sharing lessons with a broad audience on site and online. They target leading academics and experts, but are also a space for everybody with relevant knowledge on current landscape activities and initiatives. Each Landscape Talks session comprises of a whole series of related lectures that will be recorded and shared through a wide range of (online) channels also after the event.

Landscape Talks incorporate a range of voices and opinions, share knowledge and challenge conventions. Most notably, their innovative format expands and enhances discussions to a larger audience than ever before placing communities and local realities at the center of the conversation. Lectures should aim to build a community that shares the GLF vision and challenge influencers from all sectors to scale up actions required to transition towards sustainable landscapes.

- Topical fit with themes of the event, innovativeness of subject or approach presented
- Suitability for engaging format of landscape talk (no PPT)
- Storyline that sparks further discussion with all sorts of stakeholders at event and beyond, esp. communities, youth, women
